Eva completed a Bachelor of Science in Psychology and a Master of Science in Health Psychology both at the University of London (Royal Holloway and University College London).

Her Phd, also awarded by the University of London (Institute of Psychiatry, King's College), involved the evaluation of multiple family therapy for adolescent patients with anorexia nervosa in terms of patient symptomatic outcome, family change as well as treatment experience and acceptability. She has also worked as an honorary associate therapist at the Child & Adolescent Eating Disorders Service of the Maudsley Hospital in London while she was employed as a researcher at the Institute of Psychiatry.

Eva has published in peer reviewed journals and she is often hosted by the Greek media and press. She has taken part and presented at a number of international conferences and has taught at the MSc in Family Therapy at the Institute of Psychiatry and various under and post graduated courses of Athens Medical School.
