Jenny Soumaki is a child psychiatrist. She was awarded her doctorate degree by the Medical School of the University of Ioannina. She also works as a psychoanalyst member of the Hellenic Society of Psychoanalytic Psychotherapy.

Jenny has worked as a child psychiatrist in various services, among which:

- *Primary health care services*: Hellenic Centre of Mental Health and Research, Head of the Medical Pedagogical Department of Piraeus, Children's Research Centre – Doxiadis Unit,
- *Secondary health care services*: Aghia Sophia Children's Hospital, Head of the Adolescent Mental Health Unit – Christodoulakio
- *Tertiary health care services*: Head of the scientific team of *IRIS* Hostel for Adolescents, which belongs in the Association for the Psychosocial Health of Children and Adolescents (A.P.H.C.A.).

She has also worked as a supervisor of the following multidisciplinary teams:

- Child guidance Centre of Kallithea, of the Society of Social Psychiatry and Mental Health,
- Child guidance Centre, Municipality of Megara,
- Child guidance Centre, Municipality of Korydallos.

She has participated in all educational activities organized by the Child Psychiatry Clinic of Aghia Sophia Children's Hospital, in postgraduate programs in Child psychiatry Clinical Psychology, Child psychiatry and Nursing, as well as in various educational programs and seminars given for health care professionals.

Furthermore, she has taken part in six (6) international research programs and has published articles in foreign journals.

At present, she is the Vice-president (for the 8th consecutive year) of the European Society of Child and Adolescent Psychiatry (ESCAP), as well as the Secretary of the Hellenic Society of Psychoanalytic Psychotherapy.
